Prizing discounts:

Group organizer receives 15% off all regular priced merchandise in the golf shop for your prize table. Excluding Golf Balls and Gloves

Rental Clubs:

Please note that there are a limited number of sets available. We cannot guarantee availability of sets during peak season. It is advisable to ensure each player has their own set of clubs.

***Shotguns 88+:**

Shotguns at 1:30pm and later, or 8:30am and earlier will need a minimum of 88 players. Shotguns between 9:00am and 1:00pm will need a minimum of 124 players and the price will be \$10 higher than the prices indicated in the chart above, as Eaglepoint can't use other parts of the day effectively to retain revenue.



TOURNAMENT PLANNING

This summary is prepared as a guide to assist individuals in charge of golf tournaments or events planning. It may give you ideas on special events that you may want to include for your group. We will work with event organizers in providing these services

Tee Times:

Groups will start on the first hole in groups of four at nine minute intervals.

18 Hole Shotguns:

If a shotgun is the desired format, and the organizer is within 15 days of the event and is worried that they will not meet their minimum goals, it is suggested they revert to tee times if Eagle Point can accommodate them on the tee sheet, so as to eliminate the minimum number of players required. This change must be made at least 15 days prior to the event to eliminate the minimum number of players required.

9 Hole Shotguns:

They are available after 3:30pm and are a great format for a charity to host a function and keep costs down. Please contact us for details on pricing.

9-Hole or 18-Hole Handicap Tournament

This type of event enables golfers of varying abilities to compete on an even basis. This event may utilize RCGA handicaps if all participants have a current RCGA handicap. The Peoria System (or Calloway System) may be used for non-handicapped players to determine winners.

9-Hole or 18-Hole Best Ball Scramble

A tournament and/or format of golf play. All golfers hit the ball, starting at the tee. The best ball is picked after each shot, and everyone picks their ball up and hits from the spot as the best ball. The process starts all over again until the ball is putted out. Score is counted using one stroke for each best ball. This format is good for beginners, as it alleviates the pressure of playing with better players.

Closest to the Pin on a Par Three Hole

The golfer in the first group who is closest to the pin on the selected hole(s) writes his/her name on the tag and puts the marker where the shot came to rest. If following groups have an individual whose tee shot comes closer to the hole, he/she writes name on the tag under the previous names and places marker where his/her ball came to rest. The last name on the marker is the winner. A special prize may be awarded for this event.

Longest Drive

In this event the golfer in the first group who has the longest drive on the selected hole(s) writes his/her name on the tag and puts the marker where the shot came to rest. If following groups have an individual who has a longer drive, he/she writes name on the tag under the previous names and places marker where his/her ball came to rest. The last name on the marker is the winner. A special prize may be awarded for this event.

TERMS & REGULATIONS

We ask that you carefully review the policies and conditions outlined below prior to signing the Group Booking Contract, and ensure all participants are aware of these conditions. Should you have any questions or concerns in regards to the policies or conditions we will be happy to discuss them with you.

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT

*(Sorry, no personal cheques accepted)

- \$250 non-refundable deposit* is due at time of booking.
- Full payment* of balance owing for golf is required the day of your booking.
- In the event of unpaid green fee space within a group, Eaglepoint Golf Resort reserves the right to fill these spaces with stand-by players or adjust your foursomes.

LIABILITY

The event organizer and/ or organization they represent shall be held liable for any damages not associated with normal wear and tear that may arise as a result of the actions of the event guests. Replacement value will be used as a guide to the amount payable for damages, as well as any lost revenue resulting from the damage.

Eaglepoint Golf Resort shall not be responsible for personal property or equipment brought to the site of the event except when management accepts responsibility for the storage and security of items delivered to the site.

Management must be contacted prior to the set-up of displays or signage to ensure that no damage arises as a result of the set-up.

HEALTH AND LIQUOR BOARD REGULATIONS

In accordance with Health and Liquor Board Regulations of British Columbia, ***all food and beverage shall be purchased from the Eaglepoint restaurant and lounge.*** Staff are licensed under the Province of British Columbia's Serving it Right program. Staff members shall reserve the right to refuse service to any individual(s) who, in the opinion of the staff have been served a sufficient number of drinks or has consumed alcohol off premise or not sold to the individual by the operator.

No outside alcohol is permitted on the premises.

Eaglepoint Golf Resort reserves the right and will remove any person(s) from the course who are in breach of this regulation without a refund. No coolers and/or thermal bags are permitted on the course. Any on course promotions with Alcohol must purchase said alcohol through us and will be subject to a corkage fee.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Group bookings shall be played as scheduled rain or shine unless the Superintendent of Turf Care determines that the Golf Course is unplayable. In the event the golf course is deemed unplayable, we will work with you to find an alternative date, issue rain checks, or in extraordinary circumstances issue a full refund.

POWER CARTS

The tournament organizer, company representative, or company whom signs the contract will take full responsibility for the actions of the people within their event and by signing the contract, they are taking full responsibility for any damages incurred to any power carts or operators, indemnifying Eaglepoint Golf Resort of any wrong doing.

PACE OF PLAY***

All golfers **must** adhere to our Pace of Play Policy. Groups unable to keep on pace will be asked to play faster, be moved into the appropriate position on the course or may be ask to leave the course if unwilling or unable to keep with the prescribed pace of play.

DRESS CODE

Proper golf apparel and footwear must be worn at all times. No sandals, swimsuits, muscle shirts or short shorts are permitted.

GENERAL RULES

- *Instructions from the Course Marshal must be strictly adhered to.
- *Each player must play with their own set of clubs.
- *Bag, carts and power carts must be kept well clear of all tees and greens.
- *Maximum of two players per power cart.
- *All players must play in "foursomes" unless otherwise instructed by the Golf Shop.

****The group organizer is responsible for the conduct of all participants and it is the group organizers responsibility to inform the players of the rules, and ensure that these are followed at all times.***

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Reservations are recommended for the Restaurant and Lounge if no pre-planned food and beverage arrangements are made in advance. If you require advance menu planning or would like to make reservations in the Restaurant and Lounge, please let us know.

On course promotions must purchase their alcohol through us. We will charge the minimum that the BC Liquor Laws will permit.

***The number of people eating must be confirmed via email or phone 7 days prior to the event date.**

The confirmed number of people to eat is the number that will be billed.

Directions

From Kamloops

Drive the Trans Canada Highway for 10 minutes heading east and exit at Barnhartvale Road. From here it is an easy 9 km scenic drive through Barnhartvale. Just follow the signs to the course. In all, we are just a 20-minute drive from downtown Kamloops.

From Salmon Arm

On Highway 1 (Trans Canada Hwy) still east of the city limits of Kamloops, exit at Barnhartvale Road. From here it is an easy 9 km scenic drive through Barnhartvale. Just follow the signs to the course.

From Vernon

On Highway 97 you continue past Falkland, Westwold and Monte Lake. Continue for another 10 minutes and you reach Barnhartvale Road, with the “Golf Course” sign. From here it is an easy 18 km scenic drive through the rural Barnhartvale to the course.
